Dear Collette,

I am sorry not to have acknowledged this before now. Thank you for getting an early decision from your planning members regarding the relocation of our slow worms.

We have been looking at a number of potential sites and I wonder if your members gave any idea of the sort of figure they would be looking by way of a financial contribution? As a charitable trust we are not that wealthy, and about £22,000 of the proceeds of the land sale already have to go to New Forest DC as a contribution to various bits of infrastructure. The accommodation of about 3 additional slow worms should not result in significant additional maintenance costs.

It seems the auction of the land will now take place in July rather than June, but we are still working somewhat against the clock.
