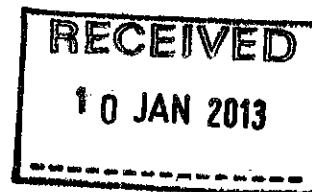

**Town and Country Planning Act 1990  
The Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012  
Confirmation of Tree Preservation Order (TPO) 24/12  
Village Mews, Vicarage Road, Marchwood,**

On 5 November 2012 the New Forest National Park Authority and the New Forest District Council tree teams combined to form a single tree service based at the National Park offices in Lymington Town Hall. The team deals primarily with Tree Preservation Orders and applications for work to protected trees within both the National Park and the District Council areas of the New Forest.

On 10 October 2012 New Forest District Council made TPO 24/12, and served you with a copy.

An objection was made about TPO 24/12 and this matter was considered by the Authority's TPO Objection Panel at a public meeting on Friday 4 January 2013. At that meeting, the Panel members decided that Oak T3 should be deleted from the schedule and plan. Accordingly, TPO 24/12 was confirmed with modifications to Schedule 1 and the plan on 10 January 2013 and I enclose a copy of the confirmation sheet together with the modified schedule and plan.

Since this document will be recorded on the New Forest District Council Land Charges Register, it is recommended that you retain this copy with your property deeds.

Confirming the TPO means that anyone wishing to prune or fell the protected trees must receive written consent from the Authority, having first submitted a detailed, written application to the Authority. Works undertaken without such consent or prior application may be in breach of the Regulations and could lead to prosecution and a maximum fine up to £20,000 for each offence.

Confirmation of TPO 24/12

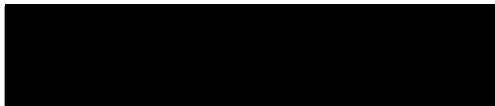
Anyone wishing to undertake works to trees protected by TPO should apply in writing to the Authority clearly identifying the tree(s) and the work intended. A decision will usually be issued within six weeks. Application forms are obtainable from the Authority's website.

If you disagree with the decision confirming TPO 24/12, you can challenge it by applying to the High Court under Sections 284 and 288 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. You can apply to the High Court if you believe:

- (1) the order is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or
- (2) the requirements of the 1990 Act or The Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012 have not been met.

You must apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date of our decision.

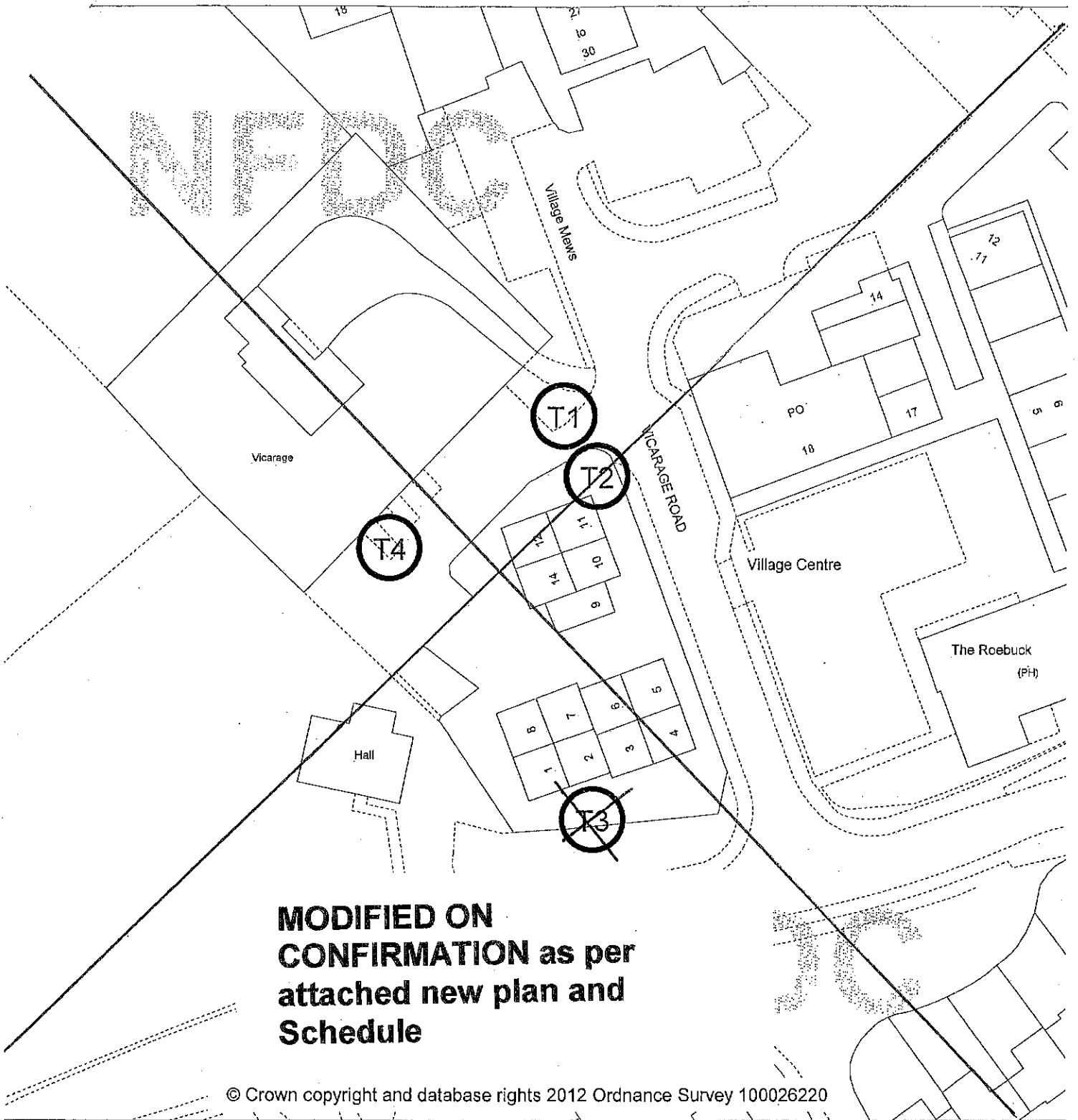

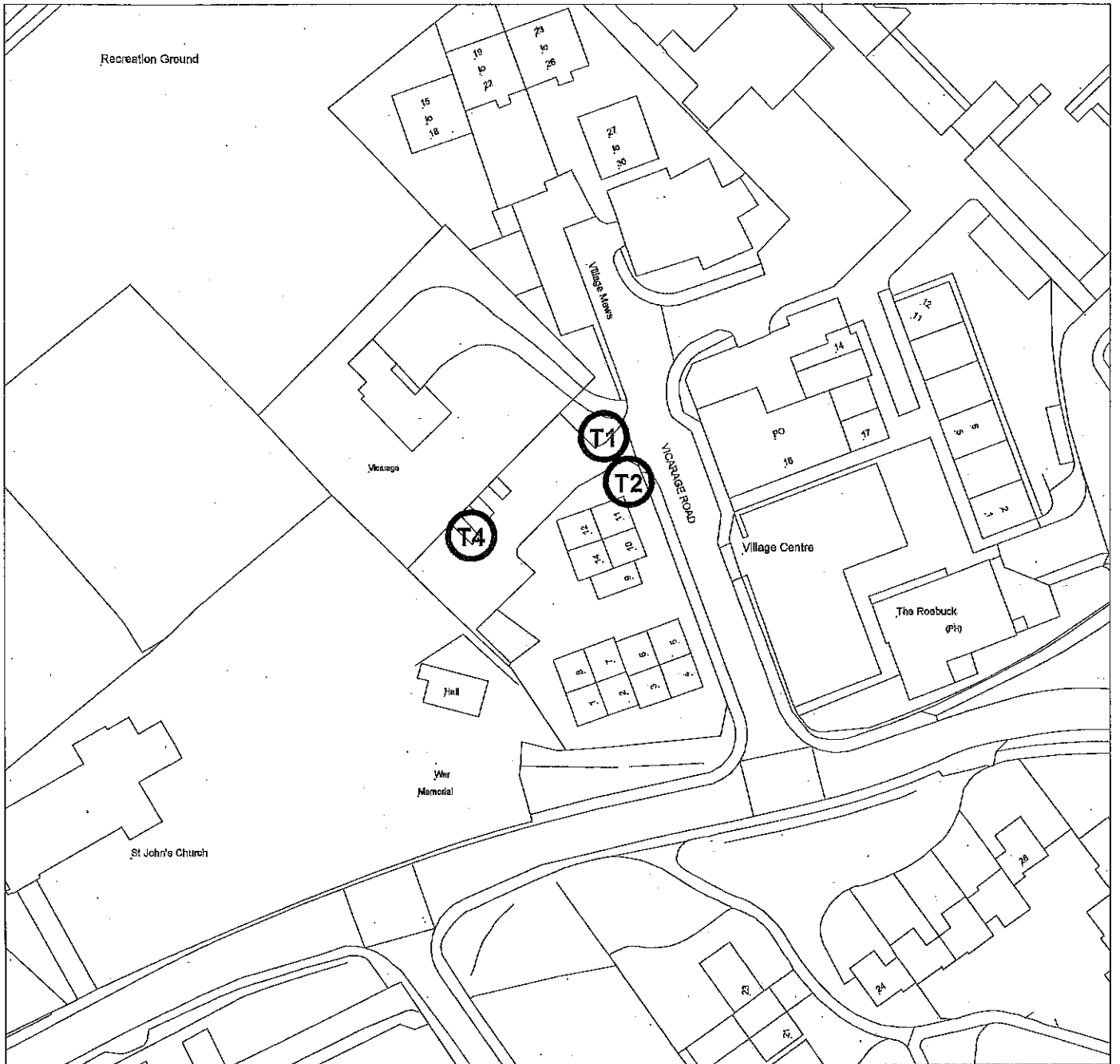

# Tree Preservation Order Plan






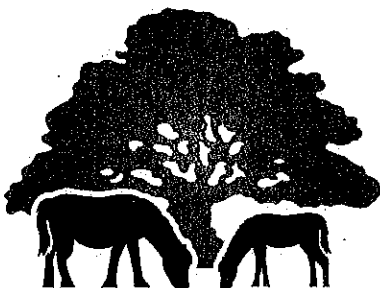
