

Adoption of a Trespass Policy

During Councillor training held in June 2013 a comment was made about needing a trespass policy to assist us should we ever have an illegal encampment on Parish Council land.

Our current insurance policy covers us for the legal expenses for getting people removed from our land but not the clean-up costs.

As we currently have no procedure / policy for dealing with illegal encampments a policy has been written and is copied below for approval and adoption.

TRESPASS POLICY

1. Delegate power to the Officers to undertake any actions necessary to assist in the speedy removal of trespassers.
2. If people are trespassing or encamped on Parish Council land contact Came & Co straight away.
3. Contact the Police and ask for their assistance.
4. Secure all other Council owned land.
5. Notify all other surrounding land owners and local authorities.
