LAND OF REDFERN AND ORCHARD VIEW, PARK LANE, MARCHWOOD**

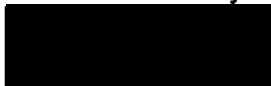
On 5 November 2012 the New Forest National Park Authority and the New Forest District Council tree teams combined to form a single tree service based at the National Park offices in Lymington Town Hall. The team deals primarily with Tree Preservation Orders and applications for work to protected trees within both the National Park and the District Council areas of the New Forest.

For your information I enclose a copy of the above TPO which came into effect on 20 November 2013.

The Authority has made this Tree Preservation Order because it is considered that premature removal or extensive pruning of the trees would result in the loss of an amenity to the local environment.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

TREE PRESERVATION ORDER TPO/0042/13

LAND OF REDFERN AND ORCHARD VIEW, PARK LANE, MARCHWOOD

The New Forest National Park Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order—

Anyone wishing to undertake works to trees protected by TPO should apply in writing to the Authority clearly identifying the tree(s) and the work intended. A decision will usually be issued within six weeks. Application forms are obtainable from the Authority's website.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the TPO/0042/13 - LAND OF REDFERN AND ORCHARD VIEW, PARK LANE, MARCHWOOD.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order "the authority" means the New Forest National Park Authority.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

3. (1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

(2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall -

(a) Cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or

(b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, uprooting, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the written consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.

Application to trees to be planted pursuant to a condition

4. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.

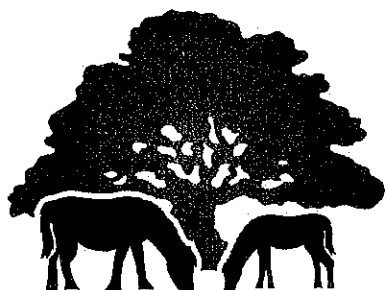
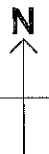
