

Licensing Act 2003 - Minor Variation Premises Licence (S41A)
Premises: The Roebuck, The Roebuck Inn, 19 Marchwood Village Centre,
Marchwood, SO40 4SF. Ref: LICPR/05/00477

An application has been received by NFDC to make the following amendment to the above licence

'To be able to provide late night refreshment outdoors to facilitate a take away service Sunday to Thursday, 23.00hrs to 23.30hrs; Friday and Saturday, 23.00hrs to 01.30hrs.'

Having looked at the information held on NFDC's website for all licensed premises the current takeaways in the village are not licenced for late night refreshments. Having spoken to NFDC Officers the Chinese takeaway did have a late night licence but they surrendered this in December 2011.

A late night refreshments licence allows premises to sell food between 11.00pm and 5.00am.

Cllr Rowlands has spoken to the applicants at the roebuck and for avoidance of doubt this is not a change to their licencing hours for alcohol nor is it a change in their licence to sell food on the premises. They can serve food and alcohol until 1:30am on certain days.

Historically they have served food to punters on request at the end of the night to take away (mainly pizza in boxes and also for contractors who takeaway breakfast in the morning).

Maria is concerned that technically this may be a breach of her other licences hence the minor amendment application. Bizarrely there is also a market for a plated Sunday Lunch!!!
