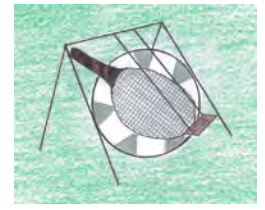

Complaint received from a user of Lloyds Rec

On the 17th September 2018 the Youth Club was hired out for a private party in the afternoon.

The party organiser's mother and disabled father was parked in front of the metal drop post by the grounds man's building. A male scout leader approached the party organiser and demanded to know whose car was parked in front of the post and insisted it was removed immediately. Saying 'move it' and according to the organiser was very aggressive. He was spoken to by the organisers Mother, saying there was no need to be so rude and aggressive. She then did move her car he proceeded to try a number of keys to unlock the drop post and when realised that the lock had been changed started to get annoyed, saying the groundsman have changed the f***ing lock again! while kicking the post. This was all in the presence of young children (8 year olds)

He then tried to loosen and kick one of the wooden dragon's teeth to gain access.

Between the Sunday and the Thursday the head groundsman noticed that a wooden post had been removed and a vehicle had driven across the football pitch with tyre marks leading to the scout hut. He has now concreted this in.

Incident two
