The village also gained some new residents this year when the fairies moved in. Have you found their new houses yet?

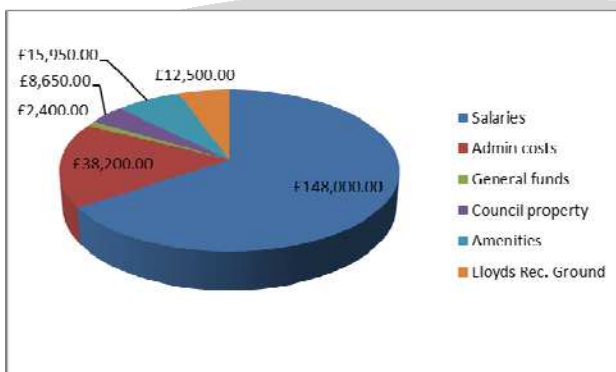
Defibrillator



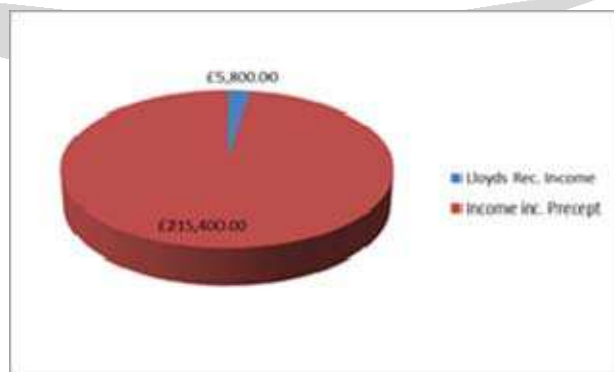
We are delighted to announce that Marchwood Village now has three more Defibrillators. The Parish Council has sited one at the Lloyds Recreation Ground, on the left hand side of the entrance to the Pavilion. One is sited at Staplewood Training Ground by the Security Office, kindly donated and maintained by Southampton Football Club and the last one is at the Security Office at the entrance of the Industrial Park. This one was donated by ABP. The Parish Council will be holding workshops with a 'dummy' Defibrillator so members of the public will be able to practice with them. The first one will be at the Village Fete in July.
