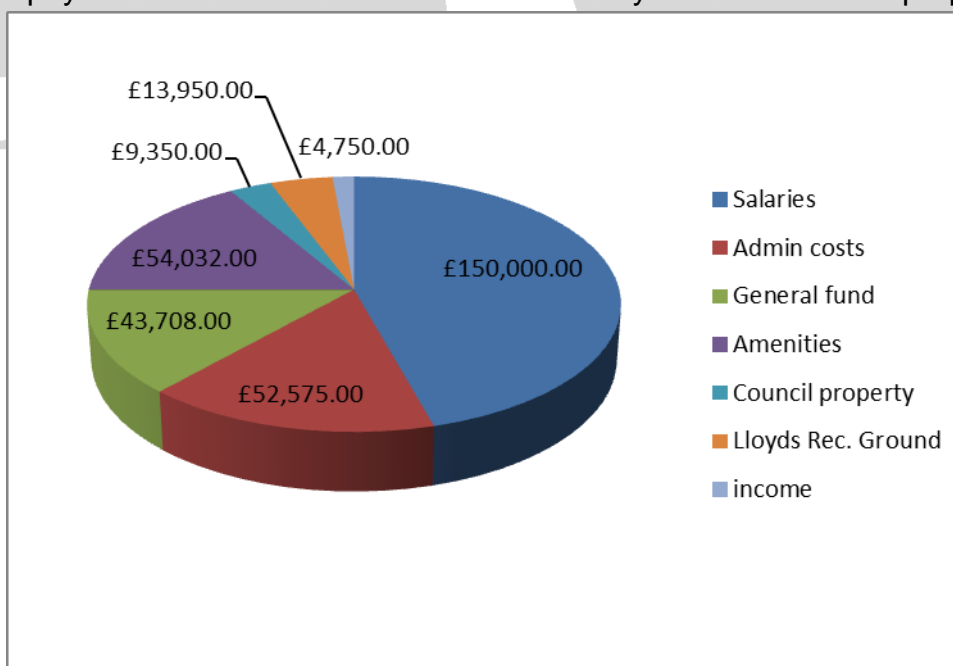
Army Covenant
