Last week I attended the dog forum in Lymington with our partners at National Trust, New Forest National Park Authority, Forestry Commission, NFDog, Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust, and Hampshire County Council. We discussed several topics around dogs and ways to address dogs under proper control, dogs worrying livestock, and owners taking responsibility to clear up dog mess. Several ideas have been considered and will be trialled throughout the summer, but the main point raised is that we need to highlight the issues in the media and promote best practice across the electronic social media networks.

This week I attended Dorset Police Southern Headquarters in a joint meeting with Hampshire, Dorset and Wiltshire Police to address and discuss rural and countryside crime trends, sharing intelligence and information on our transient criminals.

I have had several incidents regarding nesting birds this week which have kept me busy. Three well known global organisations contacted Country Watch due to their maintenance department's accidentally disturbing nesting birds on their sites. My enquiries are ongoing.
