Colleagues,

On Tuesday this week Scott and I joined some of our Northern Country Watch colleagues in providing a policing response at the Wickham Horse Fair. This is an annual event which has been running in some format or other since 1269. Our role was primarily joint patrol of the animal aspects of the event together with our RSPCA partners, dealing with animal cruelty or neglect issues or illegal sales. I am happy to report we saw very little of this type of issue this year, there were a few 'poor' looking ponies and one or two issues with overgrown or split hooves, one case of strangles but for the most part the horses were well turned out and very healthy. Unlike last year, the event passed with very few public order problems which is partly as a result of some very thorough police interaction during the lead up to the Fair.

The past week has seen the continued trend in the theft of power tools, particularly makes such as Stihl. If you own power tools please ensure they are security marked. Thieves will be put off by easily identifiable property. Put signs up showing your property is all security marked to deter their interest.

We have also seen an increase in theft from motor vehicles with both tools and personal possessions being stolen. The best way to avoid being a victim of this type of crime is not to leave anything of value in your car and also please ensure you always lock and check your car before leaving it. We are still getting quite a number of thefts from insecure vehicles.
