- Put in dragons teeth at Moss Drive to stop cars driving down ( Concrete bollard to be sited in middle of footpath)
- Remove rope swing from tree at Malthouse
- Cut up fallen tree in Crookedhays across path
- Paint over graffiti at Skate Park
- Put plants in boxes and boat ( 11/03/15)
- Plants missing from plant box at Pilgrim (12/03/15)
- Report of a tree in Ferndale Road – reported to office – reported to NFDC – recommendation to have tree removed as it looked diseased.
