### **Bury Road Cycle Path**

8. The Clerk reported that the cycle / footpath is due to be between 1.8 – 2.0m wide. Although Sustrans recommend a 2.5m wide path this is their recommendation and not a national policy. The path has been designed by HCC Engineers and is being constructed to HCC adoptable standards. Funding has been obtained from the Department for Transport on the provision of a 2m wide path.
