Support, the application is in accordance with policy CS2 of the New Forest District Council Local Development Framework Core Strategy adopted October 2009.

15/10293 & 2015/0053 – Marchwood Waste Transfer Station, Bury Road:
Variation of condition 1 of planning permission 11/98085 for the retention of the temporary waste transfer station buildings. **Concern over the amount**

of vehicle movements and request that the planning permission if granted is only for a further 5 years.

15/10294 & 2015/0055 – Marchwood Waste Transfer Station, Bury Road: Variation of condition 1 of planning permission 14/10124 for the retention of the glass bay and recyclables bay. **Support, but request that if granted planning permission this is only valid for a further 5 years.**

15/10299 – Upcott, Main Road: replace existing flat roof on rear extension with pitched roof. **Refuse, the proposed pitch roof will cause a loss of light and therefore have a detrimental impact on the neighbour. This application is therefore contrary to policy CS2 of the New Forest District Council Local Development Framework Core Strategy adopted October 2009. Request that this application is brought to the Planning Committee if Officer recommendation is different to that of Marchwood Parish Council.**

T8 reduce crown by 4m, raise crown to 5m, crown thin 20%. T9 reduce crown by 3m, crown thin 10%. T10 Fell. T11 Fell. T12 reduce crown by 4m, raise crown to 5m, crown thin 25%. T13 Fell and T14 reduce crown by 4m, raise crown to 5m and crown thin 20%. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**

15/0247 – 16 Kestrel Close: T24 Oak: thin out the crown by up to 15%. Reduce and reshape the crown by up to 1m. Clean out the crown removing any deadwood, broken branches, stumps or ivy. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**

15/0263 – 29 Admiralty Way: T7 Sycamore: thin the crown by 20% and reduce the canopy by 1m. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**

15/0287 – Millhouse, Tavells Lane: prune 1 oak. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**

15/0292 – 53 Admiralty Way: prune 1 Oak. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**
