2. A resident from The Crescent raised concerns over the CCTV cameras that have been installed at the Staplewood Training Ground. There is no indication of the area of coverage, who monitors this and what they then do with this footage. Cameras CP1 and CP20 look directly into my garden and this is intrusive.

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Planning Applications

6. **RESOLVED:** To submit observations as follows:

15/10311 – Sports Pavilion, Long Lane: CCTV cameras, 20 poles of up to 12m high, associated works. **Refuse. We are very disappointed that this application is retrospective. The application does not provide enough information on the area covered by each camera and what information the cameras capture. The cameras on the perimeter of the site should be fixed and focused within the ground only. There should be no recording of the public highway. This application is contrary to Policy CS2 as it will have an adverse effect on the adjoining amenity of residents surrounding the site.**

15/00295 – Westwinds, Beaulieu Road: detached garage, 1.5m high brick wall and gates, reposition of access. **Support, this application is in accordance with Policy DP1 of the New Forest National Park Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD adopted December 2010.**

Tree Applications

7. **RESOLVED:** To submit observations as follows:

15/0338 – Ashdown, Long Lane: T26 Hornbeam: prune tree generally by up to 2m and remove dead wood. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendations.**
