Planning Applications

6. **RESOLVED:** To submit observations as follows:

15/11302 – Marchwood CCGT Power Station, Oceanic Way: Plant & equipment (Lawful Use Certificate for retaining an existing use or operation). **Noted.**

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15/11317 – The Cottage, Hythe Road: single storey rear extension; use of garage as ancillary living. **Support this application with the condition that the annex must be used in association with the main dwelling and not as a separate unit of accommodation. The application will not have an impact on the street scene. The application is therefore in accordance with policy CS2 of the New Forest District Council Local Development Framework Core Strategy adopted October 2009.**

15/00670 – Tims Paradise, field off Twiggs Lane: Stable block. **Support this application, it will provide a better facility for the horses at this field.**

Tree application

7. Forestry Commission Open Forest Management Plan 2015/16, proposed Open Forest felling at Hanger Corner.

RESOLVED: support as this is good management of the forest.

Bury Road Cycle Path

8. The crossings and fencing along the new cycle route are being installed at present and the work seems to be progressing really quickly.

Long Lane improvements outside SFC Training Ground

9. **RESOLVED:** To support the footpath and traffic calming measures to Long Lane. Concern has now been raised about the lower section of Long Lane where there is no footpath.

New Forest National Park Authority

10. Scope of the Local Plan Review Initial 'call for views' September 2015.

RESOLVED: To make the following comments:
Dibden Bay, this is a key strategic issue that will have an effect on the National Park in terms of noise, views, emissions and traffic.
Management of tourism, the increase in tourism needs to be controlled as it will lead to more vehicles and emissions being released within the National Park.
More affordable housing for local 'forest born' families including key worker accommodation.
