Dear Councillors,

The Cork field is currently vulnerable to unauthorised vehicular access and encampments due to the lack of hedging and fencing at the site.

It is proposed to install at ten heavy duty bollards at the site where there is a lack of hedging and fencing.

The three quotes are as follows.

Supplier A £355 + VAT

Supplier B £750 + VAT

Supplier C £371.68 + VAT

It is proposed that the Council's Landscape team will install the bollards if they are purchased.

It is estimated that the costs of materials will be less than £150 in addition to the purchase of the bollards.

This item is being brought to Full Council due to the fact that the Amenities Committee does not meet until the 10<sup>th</sup> September (after the Summer Holidays).
