Southampton City Council/New Forest District Council : Clear Air Zone Consultation.

7. District Councillor Hoare explained the agreement was signed by Southampton City Council and New Forest District Council to sort out the problem with air pollution as the two areas are closely linked. 50K has been provided by Government to do extra monitoring and a business plan. The preferred option is to charge Lorries and buses £100 per day for entering the city and taxis £12.50 per day. They will need to conform to Euro 6. There will be no charge for private and resident cars. Revenue that may arise from charges is to be re-invested to facilitate the achievement of local transport policies and these should aim to improve air quality. Ships being built at present are gas powered.
