### Police in New Forest release edit of motorcycling flasher



At midday to 12.45pm , Friday, August 28, a 58-year old woman was riding along Brockishill Road in Bartley when a motorcyclist overtook her slowly. He then pulled up ahead and as the horserider passed him he exposed himself. She ignored him, but he then passed her a further two times and made suggestive remarks.

The woman has since been working with an imaging specialist to compose the edit.

The man is described as: white, late 20s to 30 years old, medium build and height, very dark hair, quite thick dark eyebrows, a very round face and a pale complexion. He rode a blue race style motorcycle which looked in good condition. He was wearing a dark blue motorcycle helmet with a flip-up visor (flip-up section not shown on edit) and a blue biker style jacket with a red stripe in the centre, and a white stripe either side of the red.

Officers are asking anyone who thinks they recognise the man or has any information about the crime to contact them.

Officers also say they would always advise anyone who knows they will be on their own in a secluded location to carry a charged mobile phone.

## Police appeal after theft of motorbike

***Police at Ringwood are appealing for information about the theft of a motorbike from a Fordingbridge garden shed.***



The owner, a 51-year-old man, left the blue Yamaha Trials bike locked and chained in a padlocked shed in the rear garden of his Shaftesbury Street home on Friday, September 6.

When he went to the shed the next day, he discovered the break-in and the bike was gone.

Today, police released a photograph of the stolen bike. PC Claire Holmes is appealing for sightings of the bike. It is difficult to start, and it is likely that the thieves may seek assistance from motorcycle repair or service centres.

Anyone with information about the bike is asked to contact PC Holmes at Ringwood on 101.

PC Holmes also advised householders to purchase alarmed padlocks to secure sheds. "Alarms are inexpensive – around £20 – and are touch sensitive. They emit a high decibel sound when disturbed," she said.

If you are involved in managing a shoot this season please ensure you send the dates and keeper contact details to us this month. This enables us to reduce the number of unnecessary deployments of Police Officers to lawful shooting activities.

On Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2013 the Country Watch team conducted a Stay Under 40 operation. During a two hour period eleven motorists were caught travelling in excess of the speed limit. Actual speeds varied from 48 – 68 miles per hour. Some of them will be offered a referral to a driver awareness training course (at their expense), some will receive a fixed penalty fine and three points on their driving licence and one of them is likely to receive a summons to go to court.
