Police seek help to find woman missing from Southampton

Police in Southampton are seeking the public's help to find a woman who has been missing from the city since Sunday, May 19.

Gabriella Montanez, 25, was last seen at her parents' flat in Atherley Road, Shirley, at about 4am that morning after an argument about her cooking a meal late at night.

Gabriella also is known as Gaby. She is a Mexican national who has been in England for seven months with her parents. She speaks perfect English with an American accent.

She is 5ft 2ins tall and slim with long, light brown hair. When last seen, she was wearing a pink sweater, black track suit trousers and sandals.

Gabriella has no phone, transport, money or bank account. She took no clothing with her and has no known friends.

Bransgore burglaries bring police witness appeal

Detectives in the New Forest are appealing to Bransgore residents for help in solving three burglaries in the area.

Three properties have been entered since May 11 by burglars who forced their way inside while the residents were out.

The first incident was between 1.40 and 2.20pm Saturday, May 11. A bungalow in Burley Road was entered while the 80-year-old woman resident was out celebrating her birthday. Thieves left empty handed when an alarm sounded, scaring them away from the property.

On Thursday, May 16, a second property in Burley Road was entered when burglars forced open a rear window sometime between 9am and 1.30pm. This time, the thieves got away with £750 of jewellery, including a Gucci watch, a three-strand bracelet and cuff links. All the items belonged to the 35-year-old woman resident.

Burglars struck again on Friday, May 24, at a bungalow in West Road. Again, they forced entry to the property between 10am and 10pm while the residents were out celebrating the man's 90th birthday.

At West Road, the burglars took commemorative coins, watches, an engagement ring and World War II medals.

Detective Sergeant Matt Taylor is appealing for information from residents of the area:

"Three burglaries in the same area in the space of a week and a half are very unusual in that neighbourhood.

"We need to hear from anyone who noticed any suspicious people or vehicles in the neighbourhood in that period from May 11 to May 24. In particular, did anyone notice unfamiliar people or vehicles on May 11 when the burglar alarm went off in Burley Road?

"Or did you notice any person or people looking at homes in the neighbourhood during that time?"

Appeal after armed robbery in Brockenhurst

Detectives have launched an investigation after an armed robbery involving a knife at a petrol station in Brockenhurst.

At around 3pm yesterday, bank holiday Monday, May 27, a man entered the Esso Service Station on Sway Road.

He managed to get behind the counter and demanded money from the cashier showing her a knife. He then ran from the store with several hundred pounds.

The man is described as aged in his mid to late 20s and of Asian appearance. He is well groomed with a trimmed beard. He had a London accent and was about 6ft 2 inches tall and stocky.

It's believed he had some sort of tattoo or mark on the left side of his neck. He was wearing a blue beanie type hat and black sunglasses. He also wore a grey/black woollen knitted jumper with a distinctive white pattern on the front and back along with blue jeans.

Officers are also today releasing two CCTV stills of the suspect and are asking anyone with any information about who he may be to contact them.

Detective Sergeant Ian Craddock said: "This was a traumatic experience for the cashier and we are keen to find the man responsible. As it was a sunny day, we are hopeful that this man would have stood out from the crowd with a jumper and beanie hat on."

"I would ask anyone who witnessed any of the incident or saw the man before or after the robbery to contact us."

"I would also like to make it clear that we have no reason at this stage to believe this incident is connected in any way with the armed robbery at the end of last year at Brockenhurst station."

Appeal to dog owner to contact police at Lymington

Police at Lymington are appealing for contact from a woman who was walking her dog in Brockenhurst at about 7pm Wednesday, May 22.

At that time, a 77-year-old Edinburgh man was walking near Tesco when he was bitten by a Lurcher-type dog. The man suffered three puncture wounds to his forearm, swelling and bruising.

The dog had a dark coat with patches of brown and grey. It attacked without provocation or warning and bit through the sleeve of a fleece and a shirt.

The woman with the dog is a woman, aged 40 to 50, who is 5ft 5ins tall and of medium build. She has dark brown hair, cut in an above-the-shoulder bob style with fringe. She wore an outdoor jacket and a skirt.

The woman apologised to the man, but then appeared to hurry away without exchanging any details. The incident was reported to police.

PC Benjamin Collins appealed to the woman to contact the police. "We need to speak to this woman or the dog's owner, if the woman with the dog is not the owner, to offer some advice and to ensure that the dog is not a danger to people," he said.

Jade Clark memorial garden opening

A garden planted in memory of Ringwood Young Firefighter Jade Clark will be officially opened on Sunday (2 June) at 2pm.

Jade was tragically killed in a road traffic accident while riding her moped on the A31 near Ringwood in February.

The 16-year-old was a much-loved member of the Young Firefighters Association (YFA) at Ringwood fire station.

In memory of Jade, Jade's YFA colleagues at Ringwood, along with instructors, have created a garden at the front of the station.

The 2 June date has been chosen for the opening as it would have been Jade's 17th birthday.

The garden will be officially opened by Spencer McCarthy, the chairman of Churchill Retirement Living, the firm that put up a reward for information during the hunt for the vehicle that collided with Jade's moped. Churchill have also contributed towards the garden.

Members of Jade's family will also be present for the opening of the garden.

The garden has been created by the tireless work of the Ringwood

YFA members, with the support of Stewarts Garden Centre in Christchurch who have helped with the supply of plants and a water feature

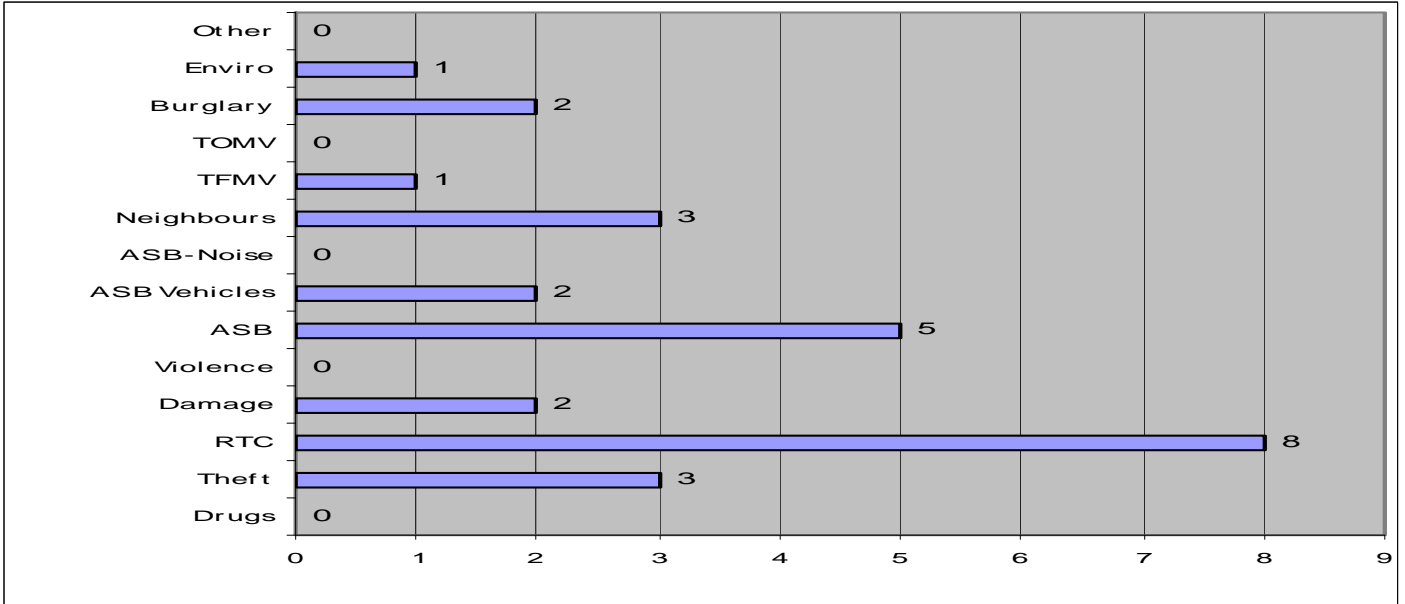
