Police seek help to identify racial abuser

Published: Thursday, August 1, 2013

At about 11am Thursday, July 25, a 42-year-old Pakistani man left the Poundstretcher store in Totton Precinct and dropped a receipt on the ground.

A white man, sitting on a nearby bench, subjected the man to a tirade of racial abuse and swearing. The white man followed the victim up the precinct towards Totton Library, continuing to swear and shout at him.

The abuser is described as a white man, aged 40 – 50, who is 5ft 8ins tall and of medium build. He is bald, with a small amount of very short hair at the sides of his head. He wore dark jeans and a light-coloured tee shirt. He had a southern English accent and appeared to be alone.

Officers who attended the incident did not find the suspect, and PC David Barnes is appealing for information from the public.

“The shopping precinct was busy at the time of the incident, and the victim noticed people looking at the suspect. We need to hear from anyone who witnessed the incident or who knows the suspect.

“Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated by Hampshire police, and we will deal robustly with such offenders,” PC Barnes said.

Police seek information on missing rings

Police at Lymington are seeking help from the public to find two valuable rings which are believed to have been taken from the bedroom of a flat in Cornwallis Road, Milford on Sea.



The rings belong to an 81-year-old woman who last saw them on or about July 10. When she went to wear one on July 24, both rings were missing.

The rings include a five-stone diamond ring, set in a half loop, of 18-carat yellow gold. This ring is valued at £2,120. The second ring is of sapphires and 14 diamonds, set in 18-carat yellow gold. This ring is valued at £1,725. Both rings were taken in their boxes.

The rings are of great sentimental value to the woman, who received them as gifts from her 91-year-old husband.

PC Dawn Pritchard is seeking help from the public. "Someone must have been offered these items. If so, we need to hear from them," she said.

Hampshire Constabulary offers advice to beat rural oil thieves

Theft in rural communities has a debilitating effect on farms and businesses, with a rise in this type of crime historically experienced across Hampshire and the Isle of Wight in the late summer months.

Theft of heating and diesel oil has been a problem for many years and is often thought to be linked to the price of crude oil.

A rise in the price of fuel often leads to a rise in the cost of heating oil, making it an attractive proposition for thieves who now actively target fuel tanks at farms, transport depots and domestic properties.

However, reducing the risk of heating and diesel oil theft can be achieved by following the simple – but effective – crime reduction actions outlined below:

Siting your oil tank: Where the tank is sited can have a significant effect on how hard a target it is in the eyes of the thief. If the tank is close to a road or path and out of sight then it is likely to be a far easier target than if it was in sight of the house with one or more windows overlooking it.

Securing the oil tank: A metal grill or cage with a lockable access point across the top of the wall or fence can help improve security. The wall or fence should be as close to the tank as possible and as high as possible.

Control switches: Consider turning off the control switches that control the flow of oil and isolate the electricity when the tank is not in use.

Oil level gauges: Remote electronic oil level gauges are available, which will set off an audible alarm if the oil level in the tank suddenly drops or falls below quarter full. The alarm receiver can be placed in the house to warn the residents. There are also similar alarms that can notify the residents by text.

Padlocks: A thief will usually come equipped to attack your tank so it is worth investing in some good quality locks. Closed-shackle padlocks are the best as they offer the most resistance as there is very little of the metal hoop (shackle) exposed for attack.

Security lights: Low-energy "dusk-to-dawn" lighting positioned close to the tank often provides sufficient lighting to illuminate any suspicious activity if the area is overlooked.

Defensive planting: Thieves will be reluctant to force their way through or over prickly vegetation. The smallest trace of blood or shred of ripped clothing could help police identify the offender.

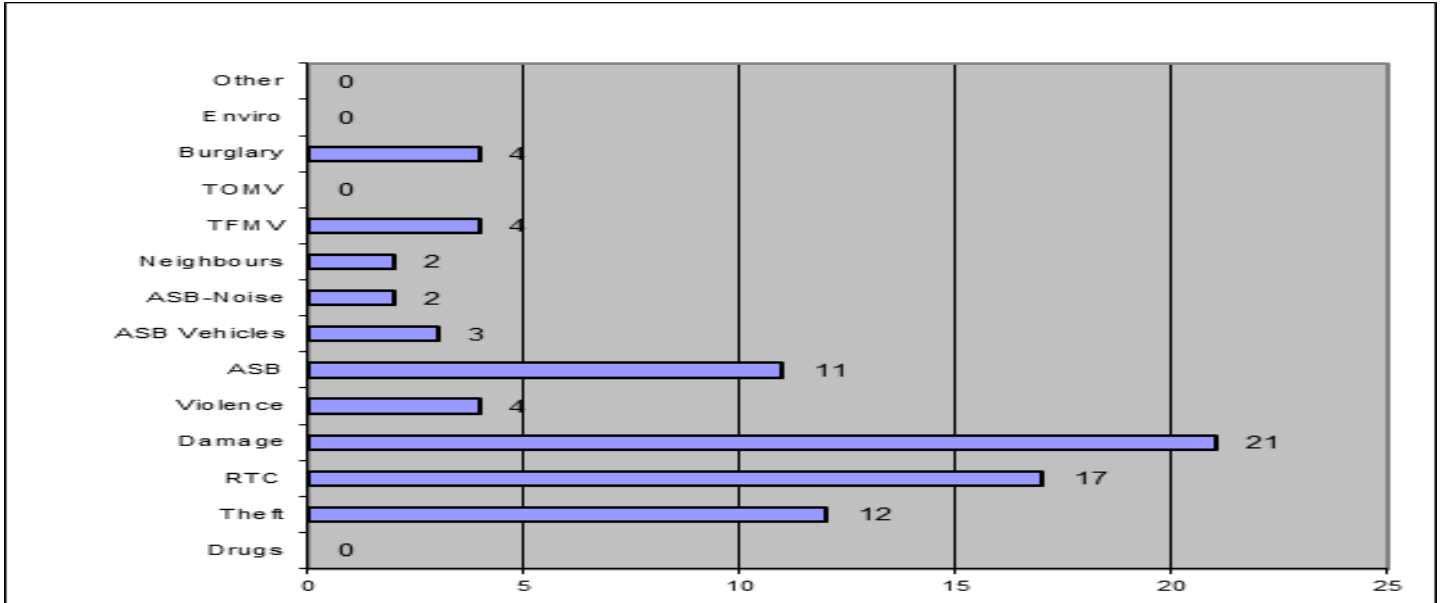
