Police at Hythe are appealing for information after thieves took spare wheels from 42 Ford Fiesta cars.

The cars were stored in a secure compound on the Marchwood Industrial Estate, where thieves entered sometime between 6 and 8.30pm Thursday, October 31.

They also took four alloy wheels from one of the Fiestas and spare wheels from 13 Transit flat bed trucks and eight Ford Ranger pick-up trucks.

It is believed the offenders used a white Transit long wheel base Hi Top to carry the wheels from the site.

The stolen items include Transit wheels with 185/70/16 Bridgestone tyres, Fiesta wheels with 196/55/15 Continental tyres and Ford Ranger wheels with 205/70/16 Continental tyres.

Police are linking this theft to a similar theft on October 4, when a similar number of wheels and spare tyres were taken from new Fords.

Police want to trace the white Transit long wheel base van used by the offenders. They also want to hear from anyone with knowledge of the theft.

Police at Lymington today released CCTV stills of two men who were in Lymington shops at the times that shoplifters struck.



At about 2pm Friday, October 11, three men entered One Stop, The Square, Lymington. After they left, staff realised that £142 worth of washing powder, shampoo and shaving gel were missing and not registered on tills. It is believed the men left towards Priestlands Road.

At 2.23pm, two of the three entered Tesco Metro in Lymington High Street. They were carrying distinctive JD carrier bags. They left by the rear exit into the Canon Street car park, setting off the security alarm.

A check of stock revealed the theft of 10 aerosol tins of Right Guard deodorant and 20 packs of Gillette Pro Fusion razor blades with a total value of nearly £47.

The first man is described as white, very slim and about 5ft 7ins tall. He is in his mid twenties and wore a white baseball cap, worn back to front; a dark blue fleece top, dark blue jeans and white trainers.

The second man is white, stocky and about 5ft 5ins tall. He has light brown hair and wore a grey McKenzie track suit with a navy blue chest section and blue trainers.

The third man is black and wore a pink top and a grey knitted beanie hat.





New Forest North Sector- Last 7 Days







New Forest East Sector- Last 7 Days



New Forest South Sector- Last 7 Days




Recorded Incidents of ASB last 7 Days by Area







Recorded Incidents of ASB in Last 30 Days by Area




Recorded Incidents of Damage in Last 30 days by Area




Recorded Incidents of Theft, Burglary or Robbery in Last 7 Days




Recorded Incidents of Theft, Burglary or Robbery in the Last 30 days




Recorded Incidents of Vehicle Crime(Theft From & Theft of Motor Vehicle) in Last 30 Days

Colleagues,

On Friday of last week the Country Watch team conducted a Stay Under 40 speeding campaign. We were joined by our colleagues from the Isle Of Wight Country Watch team as well as representatives from the Commoners Defence Association, The British Deer Society and the Head Agister. During the operation we issued ten tickets for speeding offences between 47 – 76 mph, and spoke to another seven drivers to provide advice. The partnerships were speaking with drivers and handing out information leaflets to raise awareness amongst drivers of the dangers of driving with forest stock and deer on or close to the roads. One driver was found to have an expired driving licence, therefore invalidating his insurance policy. His vehicle was seized by Police and taken away on a big recovery truck. He will have to pay around £200 to get the vehicle back, as well as attending Court to be dealt with for speeding, driving without a licence and driving with no insurance.

Please take note of the above and make sure you check the expiry date on your driving licence. It has to be renewed every ten years and an out of date licence may result in your vehicle being seized by Police.

This weekend Jim and I were delighted to be reminded of the benefits of the Country Watch network. During the week I received an e-mail from a contact stating a friend had suffered the theft of four bee hives from a location in Dorset. This had been reported to Dorset Police. Two days later we received a call from one of our members stating they had found four bee hives in a field on their land in Hampshire. Jim and I made the relevant enquiries and this afternoon we were delighted to reunite the aggrieved with his four hives and four colonies of bees. Without our members sharing this information with us it is highly unlikely that the hives would have been traced to their owner. Hampshire Country Watch – One: Dorset Police – Nil!!
