The team this week have attended some compulsory training to refresh their skills on accredited powers in relation to Fixed Penalty Notices(FPN) and Penalty Notice for Disorder( PND). The officers were also refreshed in the five stage statement writing process.

Where necessary and relevant the officers can issue penalty notices for offences such as: 1)- Failure to surrender alcohol in a designated place. 2)-Throwing fireworks. 3)-Dog Fouling. 4)-Cycle on Footpaths 4)-Graffiti and littering

### **Police at Totton are appealing for witnesses to a series of thefts from sheds in the town.**

Between 10.30pm Monday, March 11, and 7.45am Tuesday, March 12, four sheds were broken into in rear gardens in Tennyson Road and Ewell Way.

Stolen items include mountain bikes, a lobster pot and a wetsuit. One bike was recovered later in Blackwater Drive.

Police want to hear from anyone who heard the sound of windows being removed and padlocks broken or saw suspicious people or activity in the area that night. They particularly want to hear from anyone in Blackwater Drive who saw the mountain bike being abandoned.

Police also want to remind residents to keep sheds, rear garden gates and fences well maintained and secured to deter burglars.

**Western Country Watch Weekly 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2013**



Colleagues,

We are in the early stages of planning a rural conference for the summer with the theme of rural safety and crime prevention. It is likely to be on the 19<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at a venue within the New Forest. We hope to host approximately 100 members of our rural communities. Further details will follow in due course but please keep the day clear in your diary if you would like to attend.

This week I attended the South East Regional Wildlife and Environmental Crime meeting in Worthing. Police forces from across the region were represented together with the Environment Agency, RSPCA and Natural England. Several discussions took place relating to improving some of our information exchange processes and identifying ways that we can all work better together in the future.

On Wednesday the Country Watch team conducted a Stay Under 40 operation. Sixteen drivers were caught speeding between 47 – 65 miles per hour in just under two hours.

Investigations continue by various partner agencies in relation to the dog deaths around Ogdens. A partnership meeting is being scheduled for next week to review all of the information available.

We are approaching the time of year when we start to see movements of travellers into the region. Please take time to check the security of your land and gateways. Consider blocking any entrances not in regular use and ditch field edges where possible to prevent access to land.

Hampshire Constabulary has joined forces with the UK's only official ACPO approved marking scheme for agricultural machinery - CESAR - to offer Farmers and Land Owners in Hampshire the opportunity to have their machinery and equipment protected by CESAR at a heavily discounted price

You should all be aware that machinery thefts are on the increase throughout the UK. Items ranging from 300 horse power tractors to quad bikes and trailers are disappearing from yards and fields on a daily basis. Fortunately the New Forest area has not been hit too hard to date.

As a preventative measure the Western Country Watch team have linked in with the UK's only official ACPO approved marking scheme for agricultural machinery, CESAR (Datatag). Datatag have been protecting property and machinery for over 15 years. Using state of the art identification technology linked to a 24/7 secure and accredited database the system assists with the identification and recovery of stolen equipment.

Western Country Watch will be holding three events at different locations in the New Forest during March and April 2013. At these events you will be able to have your registered machinery fitted with a CESAR system. This includes an identification plate, glass tags, data dots and more.

The Cesar Systems usually costs £149 + VAT. However, through funding obtained from the New Forest Community Safety Partnership we are able to subsidise a number of systems. We are able to offer two systems per person for a massively discounted price of £73.40 per system (no VAT), and each extra marking after that at £105 per system (no VAT).

It is worth noting that CESAR marked equipment can attract up to 12.5% discount on insurance when covered by the NFU. You may need to speak to your own insurance company if not with the NFU to discuss any discounts.

Spaces are limited with only twenty pieces of machinery able to be marked per day. Bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis and need to be booked with Datatag direct on 07811 700936, and not through Country Watch. Please open the attached PDF document for details of the dates and locations. You will also find the details of how to book your machinery in to be marked.

## **Safeguarding the future of safer seas**

**Friday, 15 March 2013**

Support for a Hampshire-based charity dedicated to sea rescue missions has received a lifeline from Hampshire County Council.

At his Decision Day (14 March 2013), Leader of Hampshire County Council, Councillor Ken Thornber, awarded funding of £41,500 to the Solent Sea-Rescue Organisation.

The charity was established by the County Council in 1977, in partnership with local maritime authorities, to assist in sea rescues on the foreshore of the Solent and surrounding beaches.

It brings together eight independent lifeboat and rescue organisations, provides beach safety, as well as attending inland incidents. The organisation also gives regular sea and water safety talks to local community groups.

The funding will be used to cover the general running costs of the organisation.

Councillor Thornber, said: "The Solent is recognised as one of the busiest waterways in the world and there are a number of obvious dangers it poses. It is therefore disappointing that some local authorities have chosen to withdraw their funding to an organisation that does such exceptionally good work in keeping Hampshire's waters safe.

"Despite the ongoing financial pressures faced by all in the public sector, we recognise that the Solent Sea-Rescue Organisation provides a vital service to all users of the Solent and we have chosen to fund the financial shortfall they would otherwise have faced."
