The venue for this event in The New Forest, which starts at 10.00 am and finish at 4.00 pm is shown below.



Western Weekly:

19th September 2013

Colleagues,

The Western Country Watch team have had an extremely busy week:

Last Thursday I provided a train-the-trainer day for our training department who are going to be responsible for delivering rural crime training across the force in the coming months. It was an opportunity for them to go through the information for the training sessions to ensure the legislation and powers are correct, and for me to provide tactical advice about practical policing experiences that officers on the ground will be able to relate to.

Last Friday I attended the South East Regional Wildlife and Environmental Crime Partnership meeting. This provides a forum for all of the Police forces from the South East region to get together, and to engage with Natural England, Environment Agency, RSPCA, IFSEC and the National Wildlife Crime Unit. Various discussions took place around a number of topics and individuals were identified who are carrying out criminal activities across Police force borders.

On Saturday Scott and I attended the Romsey Show. We were joined by our colleagues from the Firearms Licensing Department and were able to answer many queries posed to us. Thank you to all who came to see us on the stand.

On Sunday Scott and I were at the Hampshire Country Sports Day in Alresford. Once again we worked with colleagues from our Firearms Licensing Department. During the day we had several hundred visitors to the stand and assisted over 140 members of the public with specific firearms and shotgun related queries. A huge amount of work has been done in the last twelve months to address the issues previously experienced within the firearms licensing department with unacceptable delays. The feedback we received at the recent shows is evidence in itself that the department has made huge improvements. Thank you to those who took the trouble to visit us to tell us that we're starting to get things right! You're all too quick to let us know when we get things wrong!

Tuesday morning saw the team assisting the Agisters and commoners by carrying out traffic control at a pony drift. This helps to ensure the safety of riders taking part in the drift, ponies being drifted and other road users.



Tuesday afternoon was taken up with a meeting with the Environment Agency Fisheries Department. We are keen to work with them to identify those individuals committing this type of crime. Scott will be busy developing intelligence packages on those of interest with a view to carrying out future partnership operations.

On Wednesday I assisted our Training Department to deliver the first of the Day 2 sessions of the Rural Awareness Course. The input was well received by Officers with a few minor tweaks required to the information provided. Between now and January 2014 we will train over 1200 front line Police Officers and staff who are working in your rural communities.

During the week Alan and I have also attended two meets of the New Forest Hounds who have been out enjoying the early morning Forest.

In addition to all of the above commitments we have continued to conduct site visits, provide security advice, undertake reassurance patrols in our vulnerable locations, respond to incidents reported to us and keep on top of the day-to-day tasks required of us.

Not bad for a team of three!! (Jim has been on leave for three weeks).
