### **Man charged following armed robbery in Brockenhurst**



***A 36-year-old man has been charged following an armed robbery last month, involving a knife, at a petrol station in Brockenhurst.***

At around 3pm on bank holiday Monday, May 27, a man entered the Esso Service Station on Sway Road.

He managed to get behind the counter and demanded money from the cashier, showing her a knife. He then ran from the store with several hundred pounds.

Zak Mehta of no fixed abode was arrested in the London area yesterday. He has since been charged with robbery and possession of a knife in a public place. He is due before Southampton Magistrates Court today, Thursday, June 13.

A 29-year-old woman arrested at the same time has been released without charge.

## Flying the flag for the Armed Forces in Hampshire

**Wednesday, 19 June 2013**

Hampshire residents are being invited to show their support for the Armed Forces by joining in the celebrations to mark the start of Armed Forces week.

Hampshire County Council and Winchester City Council will be marking Armed Forces Week with a flag raising ceremony in Winchester on Monday 24 June 2013. This is an annual event that helps raise public awareness of the military and gives the local community the opportunity to show their support for the Armed Forces. The ceremony will include a military band leading a Tri-Service march past through Winchester city centre.

The lunchtime celebrations begin on Monday at 11.45am with a Winchester Garrison Band, comprising musicians from The Band & Bugles of the Rifles and The Adjutant General's Corps, playing a selection of military music at the Buttercross in the centre of Winchester's High Street.

The band will then march down the High Street where it joins a contingent of 45 service personnel drawn from the Royal Navy, the Army and the Royal Air Force. At 12.35pm the band will then lead them up the full length of the High Street to The Great Hall, Castle Avenue, where the Armed Forces Flag will be raised at 1pm.

HM Lord-Lieutenant of Hampshire, Dame Mary Fagan, Leader of Hampshire County Council Councillor Roy Perry, and Mayor of Winchester, Councillor Ernest Jeffs have organised the flag raising ceremony.

The Lord-Lieutenant, who will inspect the Parade, said: "The annual Flag Raising Ceremony demonstrates Hampshire's strong commitment to our Armed Forces and the appreciation we have for all that they do. I am delighted that representatives from all three services will join us for this year's ceremony and I hope that members of the public will show their appreciation by turning out to support the contingent as they march through Winchester, and attending the short ceremony outside The Great Hall."

Councillor Roy Perry said: "Hampshire is home to the largest contingent of Armed Forces personnel in the country and we are immensely proud of our strong connection with the armed forces. Operational units of all three services are based here along with the headquarters of both the British Army and the Royal Navy. As a local authority, we want to show our debt of gratitude for the contributions and sacrifices of the armed forces community and all that they do to protect our country and serve the cause of freedom. I hope that people from around the county will join us in Winchester for these celebrations."

The Mayor of Winchester, the Right Worshipful, Councillor Ernest Jeffs, said: "Last month I signed a Community Covenant in recognition of Winchester's close connections with and support for the Armed Forces. I am looking forward to the flag-raising ceremony as a great opportunity to show that support and as a marvellous spectacle for the city."

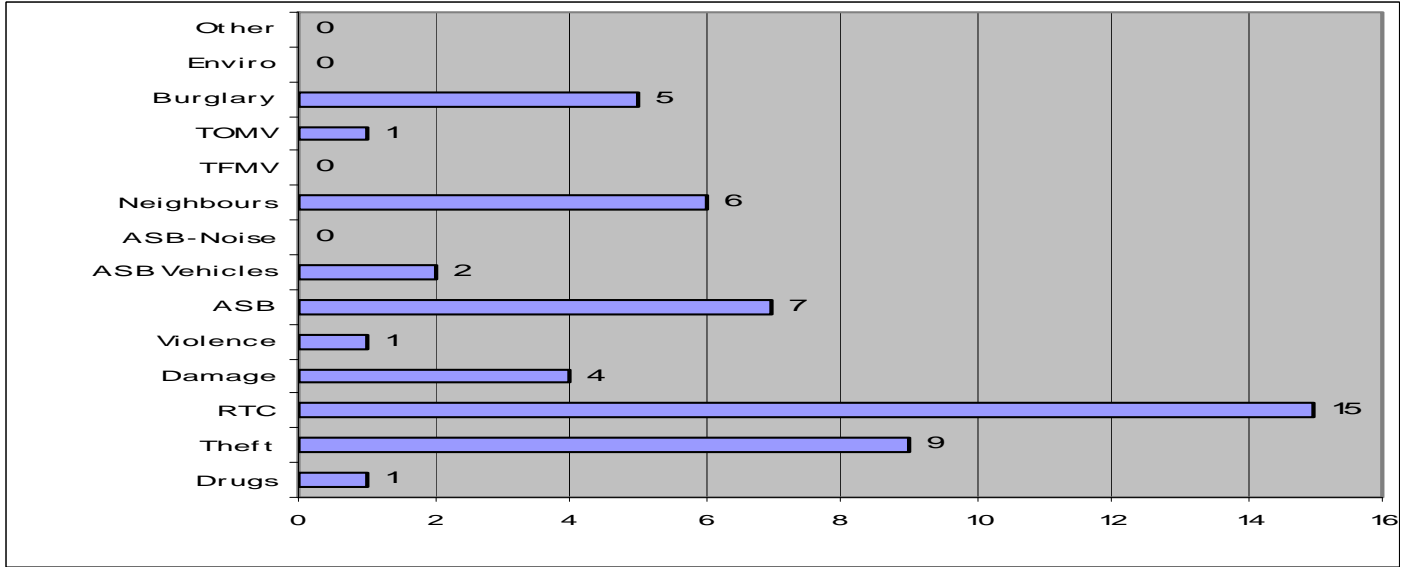

# COUNTRY WATCH

Western Weekly:

20<sup>th</sup> June 2013

On Wednesday many of you attended the Western Country Watch Conference at the Balmer Lawn Hotel. The day was a huge success with many varied speakers offering presentations on a wide variety of rural topics. The display stands contained information on products, services and support networks available for rural communities. The Chief Constable and Police & Crime Commissioner were in attendance for the morning session and provided reassurance around their commitment to rural crime. Thank you to all who attended, and also for the huge amount of positive feedback you have provided since yesterday. The Police & Crime Commissioner has intimated that he would like it to become an annual event.....!

This week two attempted thefts of lead from the roof of premises in Fordingbridge and Marchwood took place. One offender was foiled by finding anti-vandal paint on the lead and the second found that the roof was covered with lead replacement material following a previous theft. Both roofs were left intact. Please consider implementing similar crime prevention measures wherever possible.

- 14/06. Fordingbridge. Two males were seen at a trout farm, it was later discovered that an unknown quantity of trout have been stolen.

### **Theft From Motor Vehicle**

- 05/06. Ampfield. Smashed passenger window and a handbag stolen from front seat.
- 14/06. Fordingbridge. A catalytic converter was cut from a minibus.

### **Rural Theft**

- 12/06. Shootash. An angle grinder was used to cut through a gate and padlocks into a secure yard, offenders then stole £1400 worth of heating oil, £2400 worth of diesel and caused nearly £1000 worth of damage.
- 13/06. Lymington. Two Suzuki outboard motors and parts worth over £45,000 have been stolen from a rural farm premises.
- 13/06. Ringwood. A Husqvarna chainsaw worth £200 and a Lawn King hedge strimmer worth £200 has been stolen from a secure barn.
- 13/06. Ringwood. A vehicle was stolen from an open barn workshop after an untidy search was conducted; the vehicle was later discovered and recovered by the police, investigation ongoing.
- 13/06. Fordingbridge. An attempt theft of lead from a roof. The offender was deterred when they discovered anti-vandal paint on the lead.
- 13/06. Hythe. £2500 worth of electrical cable, an unknown quantity of lead and a £70 Dewalt battery stolen from secure premises.
- 13/06. Ringwood. Attempt break into rural garages.
- 13/06. Marchwood. We have evidence that offenders have gained access to a roof in an attempt to steal lead, the offenders left the scene empty handed when they discovered lead replacement materials.
- 15/06. Lymington. A Stihl hedge strimmer worth £400 was stolen from a secure shed.
- 15/06. Bransgore. A secure barn was entered by unknown person(s) via a small air vent, Various machinery and plant keys stolen.
- 15/06. Brockenhurst. A Stihl strimmer and leaf blower worth £400 stolen from a secure shed.
- 15/06. Pennington. A Bosch hedge trimmer worth £250 stolen from a secure shed.
- 16/06. Ower. Over £7000 worth of power tools stolen from a secure shed.
- 17/06. Bransgore. A John Red and Stihl Chainsaw stolen from a secure workshop.
- 17/06. Brockenhurst. A Strike electric fence energiser stolen from a paddock.
- 17/06. Rockbourne. A storage container was forced open causing damage, several fishing nets were stolen from within.
- 17/06. Blackfield. A power drill and charger was stolen from a secure shed.
- 18/06. New Milton. Two metal storage containers were forced open causing damage, various power tools stolen.
- 18/06. New Milton. 500ltrs of diesel stolen from a secure compound.
- 19/06. West Wellow. Two wooden cross country jumping fences stolen from a paddock.



### Miscellaneous Offences

- 14/06. Nursling. Travellers have been removing padlocks to gates, to gain access to open land; they attempted to encamp but were swiftly moved on by landowners and the Police.
- 15/06. Nursling. A piglet was killed by a dog which was not kept under proper control, the dog owner has accepted full responsibility and settled the compensation with the farmer under a Police Community Resolution (Police intervention).
- 18/06. West Wellow Common. Report of two dogs chasing livestock, investigation ongoing.
- 19/06. Michelmersh. A white Ford Transit panel van has been in the area offering tarmac for sale.

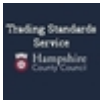

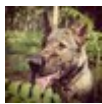
