Police appeal to thief to return photos from handbag snatch

Published: Wednesday, November 27, 2013

The photos were in the handbag of a 44-year-old New Milton woman who was the victim of theft on Friday morning, November 15.

Between 8-8.30am, the woman was walking to the car park between Ashley Road and Elm Avenue, New Milton, having posted a letter at the town's post office. She walked along Ashley Road, towards Old Milton Road. Just after Pettengells Estate Agents, she turned left into an alleyway to the car park.

The woman felt her handbag being tugged away, and saw a man on a bicycle pulling at the straps. This man is described as slim and in his twenties. He wore a scruffy green puffa jacket, blue jeans, trainers and a grey or brown woolly hat.

The handbag is black leather with two thin shoulder straps. It contained a blue and white tartan purse with a gold clasp. The purse contained £300 cash. Also in the bag were codeine tablets and four photographs of the woman's children – two of a boy and two of girls.

One of the photographs is of the woman's deceased daughter, and it is one of the only remaining photographs of the child. Of all the items in the stolen handbag, this photograph is the only thing she wants returned.

Police are appealing for information from anyone who saw the incident or who saw a cyclist of the thief's description riding in or away from Ashley Road car park. They also would like to hear from anyone who finds the discarded handbag.

PC Kieron Maddock is investigating the theft. He said: "I appeal to the person responsible for the theft to return the photograph to New Milton police station. It is the least he can do."






New Forest North Sector- Last 7 Days




New Forest East Sector- Last 7 Days



New Forest South Sector- Last 7 Days




Recorded Incidents of ASB last 7 Days by Area







Recorded Incidents of ASB in Last 30 Days by Area




Recorded Incidents of Damage in Last 30 days by Area




Recorded Incidents of Theft, Burglary or Robbery in Last 7 Days




Recorded Incidents of Theft, Burglary or Robbery in the Last 30 days




Recorded Incidents of Vehicle Crime(Theft From & Theft of Motor Vehicle) in Last 30 Days

This week we have an appeal from Hampshire Constabulary Dog Support Unit. They are currently looking for training venues throughout Western Hampshire that they can use. They are keen to build up a portfolio of estates that are Police dog friendly. The DSU are looking for a mixture of terrain including short/long grazing pasture, scrub, fallow fields, woodland areas surrounded by paths or open fields, large barns and vacant/unused buildings. These would be used for a combination of tracking, searching, and suspect location training. An initial site visit would be conducted to assess the suitability of the land, and access points, parameters and constraints would be agreed with the land owner. I know some of you already support our DSU and benefit from an increased visible Policing presence on your land. If anyone else is able to assist our DSU with this request please let us know and we will pass on your details.

There has been an increase in the theft of horse feed and hay this week, if you are in a position to conceal or lock up your equine products this will reduce the risk of becoming a target. Insecure stables have been targeted this week.

The Country Watch team conducted a 'Stay under 40' operation this Wednesday; we issued 14 speeding tickets over a two hour period at Crockford B3054 near Beaulieu Heath and Roger Penny Way near Fritham. On the whole most motorists were travelling at or below 40mph, but a few we caught were travelling at 55mph!

On Tuesday evening Louise and I attended the annual NFU meeting at Burley, it was a very well supported meeting and Louise gave an update on rural crime in your area.

The cold weather is upon us, the long range forecast would suggest freezing conditions over the next few months. Although the weather presenters can't seem to get it right there is one thing we can predict... theft of heating oil and diesel. This is the time of year that many of you are replenishing your oil reserves, if you are about to receive a delivery please could we ask that you double check your tanks, ensure that you receive the oil you've paid for. Consider fitting an alarm which will monitor the flow rate of the oil. Country Watch can offer advice on the correct products; they are reasonably priced considering the costs of oil.
