Police appeal for witnesses to Holbury assault

Published: Thursday, July 11, 2013

Police are appealing for information from witnesses to a Holbury assault in Long Lane which left a man hospitalised.

At about 2am Sunday, July 7, a 46-year-old man heard raised voices outside his home. He then discovered that his works vehicle had been damaged and saw a man and woman, who had been arguing, walk away.

The van-owner went outside to speak to the couple and was badly assaulted. He lost consciousness and suffered serious injuries which were treated overnight at Southampton General Hospital.

PC Adrian Jones is appealing for witnesses who may be able to identify the man and woman who were arguing.

"This would appear to be an unprovoked attack on a man who had just had his vehicle damaged. We need to identify the man and woman who were heard arguing in the area just prior to the assault," PC Jones said.

Witness appeal after Lymington public order incident

Police are appealing for information from witnesses to a public order incident in St Thomas Street, Lymington, on Saturday night, June 29.

Between 11 and 11.55pm an incident started outside the Kings Arms Hotel. A number of people became involved, and the disturbance moved up St Thomas Street.

A 31-year-old Pennington man was left with injuries consistent with being struck in the face with a glass. He also had cuts to his face, back and arms, but he did not require hospital treatment.

Lyndhurst PC Adrian Jones is investigating. "I am looking for assistance from the public to identify those involved in this public order incident. There were a number of people in the area at the time," PC Jones said.

This week a road traffic collision occurred when a car driver stopped to ask directions from a horse rider on a road. They were on opposite sides of the road in an area of dappled shade and bright sunlight. The horse was struck from behind by another vehicle, the driver of which didn't see the horse and rider in the shade. The horse had to be destroyed and the rider sustained broken ribs and vertebrae. An investigation is on going at this time. Please consider wearing high-visibility clothing when riding a horse on a road.

A few reports have been received of telephone incidents. People have received a call from a withheld number where the caller states they are working with the Police. They claim to be offering alarms and security advice on behalf of the Police and need to ask questions about the house and the occupants. Please ensure that you do not disclose any personal information to anyone over the phone, particularly names, ages and movements of occupants or details of any existing security products you may have.
