1. Apologies were received from Cllr Jackson.

2. The applicant from Lilley Close addressed the meeting and explained that they had consulted their neighbours before submitting their application.

### **Chairman's Report**

4. The Chairman would like clarification on the ownership of the grass verges in Long Lane. It is believed that SFC have a licence to cultivate from HCC. The water discharge from the car parks disperses into the ditch which has flooded this year. Is this going to get worse due to the amount of hard surfacing at the club? What is happening about the footpath along Long Lane? Plans have been drawn up and it should be installed this financial year.

## Planning Applications

6. **RESOLVED:** To submit observations as follows:

14/10676 – Tank storage adj. Area F12, Oceanic Way, Marchwood Industrial Park: Installation of 6 no. LPG storage tanks contained within a perimeter stone filled gabion basket retaining wall. **Support, but does the application met the requirements of the blast zone?**

14/10723 – El Pueblo, Long Lane: first floor rear extension. **Support, but there are concerns of overlooking the neighbours.**

14/10831- 10 Adams Wood Drive: roof alterations and dormers in association with creation of new first floor incidental accommodation to garage; external staircase; fenestration alterations. **Refuse, this application is out of character and detrimental to the street scene. It is therefore not in accordance with policy CS2 of the New Forest District Council Local Development Framework Core Strategy adopted October 2009.**

14/10843 – 8 Poplar Drive: first floor side extension. **Support.**

14/10879 – 4 Lilley Close: two storey rear extension; fenestration alterations. **Support, but would like a condition to make the glass in the window on the side elevation obscured.**

14/10884 – Staplewood Training Ground, Long Lane: inflatable dome over existing 3G artificial pitch. **Support, request that the dome is camouflaged to blend in with its surroundings. Support that the permission for the dome approved in permission 13/10844 is revoked.**

## Tree application

7. **RESOLVED:** To submit observations as follows:

14/0667 – 9a Park Close: Prune 1 Oak tree. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendation.**

14/0729 – 8 St Johns Drive: prune 1 Birch tree. **Support, subject to Tree Officers recommendation.**
