5. **RESOLVED:** To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 11th February 2019 as a true record. The Chairman duly signed the minutes.

AMF Supervisor's report

6. The AMF Supervisor who was not present at the meeting. In his absence the Deputy Clerk presented a verbal report with the main headlines listed as follows.

- Cradle swing in Under 12's taken down as shackles are missing
- Graffiti on play equipment at Under 12's – all cleaned off

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- Graffiti on concrete seats village centre – all cleaned off
- Fly tipping Cork Field
- Cradle swing repaired and reinstated
- Dog fouling in Lloyd play area – all cleaned up
- Removal of 3 bags of dog's poo hung up in trees at Crooked Hayes
- Fly tipping Cork Field again!
- Dog bin broken – taken down and welded and repaired (Kingfisher)
- Seats removed from the Lloyds Rec and bottom field of Oaklands
- Tiles at the Lloyds play area under swing pulled up – stuck back down again
- Concrete seat pushed over in village – re installed
- Repaired the shutter to Youth Club – hit by football
- Picked up fly tipping in Tavells Lane
- Dog mess on Falklands Memorial – cleaned up
- Put up security light for Youth Club
- Fly tipping Cork Lane
- Legionnaires check at the pavilion
- Height barrier removed – found, repaired and secured
- New foot board fitted to the bridge at Oaklands
- Foot pad on gym equipment missing – ordered new on also knife damage
- Water leak at the Lloyds – sorted now
- Grass cutting in full swing
- Summer Groundsman starts next month (May)

The Deputy Clerk explained to members about the leak at the Lloyd Recreation Ground and a full report will be given at the next meeting of the Parish Council. Members commented on how nice the 'Boat' was looking.

Report on update in and around the Village

7. The Deputy Clerk reported that the majority of the tree works have now been completed as per the last minutes.
Bridge at Oaklands: A replacement deck plank has been installed at the cost of £325.00 exc VAT.

8. The Deputy Clerk reported that five new benches have been ordered at the cost of £2,976.00 Inc VAT to replace the old wooded ones. They are all galvanised steel powder coating in green to match the existing ones in the village. They are due to be delivered at the beginning of May.
12. The Deputy Clerk said that she hope to re-mark the Football Pitch at the Lloyd Recreation Ground prior to the start of the 2019-20 Football season. That she has submitted a grant application form for new 'wheeled' goal posts and that she is seeking quotes to completely replace the tiles of the Home/Away and Referees showers in the changing rooms.

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13. Long Lane Footpath: It was reported that the consultation with resident regarding an agreement for the footpath to be laid out by their properties has been rejected by the residents due to security reasons.
A member stated that consultation will continue with the residents.
