## Lloyd Recreation Ground – Update of Play Equipment

We have received three quotes for the update of some of the play equipment at the Lloyd Recreation Ground.

The trim trial, swings and springy animals had acceded their life span. The swings being over 30 years old and we also requested a quote for a new soft closing gate as the current one has lost its spring and needs replacing.

The play house and roundabout are remaining.

All quotes came within the budget given of £25,000 excluding VAT

We have a current EMR for the replacement of play equipment at the Lloyds of £10,725
