Dear Councillors,

I enclose a letter from Mrs Judy Saxby concerning the end of her term as a representative of the Parish Council on the Dibden Allotments Fund (DAF) sitting as one of its trustees.

The Parish Council has been asked by the Clerk to the Trustees to advise the DAF whether it wishes to re-appoint Mrs Saxby as a trustee for a further term or if it wishes to appoint someone else.

I have spoken with the Clerk to the Trustees and she has told me that although the Parish Council is being asked to appoint a trustee to the DAF as its representative it is not a prerequisite that the person appointed should be a councillor.

She has also indicated that the length of time the appointment lasts may also be varied from between one year to a maximum of four years.

I hope all this is in order.
