0/10778 12 The Armoury, Boardwalk Way, Marchwood, Southampton SO40 4AX:
Erection of a means of enclosure, railings and gates within the curtilage of the dwelling house.

Marchwood Parish Council has **no objection** to the application and is happy to see it dealt with by the delegated case officer.

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The Council would also like to provide support for the proposal to have the railings positioned as free-standing items as explained to it by the applicant's agent at this meeting.

The Council does not think it prudent to insist that the railings are fixed to the boundary walls or the residence itself as this would compromise listed buildings.

The Royal Naval Armaments Depot at Marchwood contains many listed buildings that are locally significant.

The proposal to provide free-standing railings is the least invasive solution to meeting the requirements of the applicant.
